About Kino Bambino

Kino Bambino is an initiative providing new parents/grandparents the opportunity to enjoy grown-up films (up to certificate 15) with others, in a safe environment free from the concern about bothering other customers and with the film played at adapted levels.

The Showroom has applied for and received special permission from Sheffield City Council for these screenings, and the conditions must be adhered to.

Screening Conditions

The volume must be played at slightly lower levels, this is to protect the hearing of the babies. The lights must be left slightly raised, to enable the parents to see what is going on, and so as not to scare the babies.

Ticketing & Admissions

Kino Bambino is a club, the club members are the babies themselves and membership expires when the baby is one year old. Application forms for Kino Bambino are available at box office and from our website.

- Only babies under one year old may be admitted, and they must be Kino Bambino members.
- No older children over one year old are able to be admitted, regardless of the film certificate.
- The baby may 'bring' more than one accompanying adult with them.
- No unaccompanied adults may be admitted to Kino Bambino screenings.
